Thrive DC Donor Privacy Policy

Thrive DC is committed to respecting the privacy of our donors.

Information Collected. Here are the types of donor information that we collect and maintain:

- contact information: name, organization/company, address, phone number, email address
- donation information: amounts donated, date of donation(s), and method
- information concerning hours you have volunteered
- your requests and comments
- non-personally identifiable information, such as how many hits our website receives, and if the visitor is repeat or new. This requires that a 'cookie' be sent to your web browser.

How Information is Used. Thrive DC uses your data to maintain records of donations, send acknowledgements, mail year-end tax statements to you, send newsletters, notices and direct mail pieces, and for internal marketing purposes.

We normally add you to our mailing list, unless you request otherwise. Our third-party mailing service is contractually obligated to treat the lists with confidentiality and is prohibited from transferring them elsewhere.

We do NOT list individuals' names in ANY of our publications without prior consent. Corporate and Foundation sponsors may be listed in our reports and event programs.

We use your written comments/letters occasionally to post on our website (in an anonymous fashion), and to respond to your inquiries.

No Sharing of Personal Information. Thrive DC will not sell, rent, trade, or transfer your personal information to outside organizations. Use of donor information will be limited to the internal purposes of Thrive DC and only to further the mission of Thrive DC. Nevertheless, security measures may not prevent all losses, and Thrive DC is not responsible for any damages or liabilities relating to security failures.
